

# RIDING PUBLIC TRANSIT

## Robertson County

*A Step-by-Step Guide to Using Public Transportation in Robertson County*



### STEP 1: SCHEDULE YOUR RIDE

#### Demand and Response (County-Wide)

- Call ahead 1 to 7 days in advance
- Provide pickup and drop-off information
- Give your appointment or desired arrival time
- Schedule your return trip at the same time
- Trips are scheduled based on availability
- Curb-to-curb service

*Not sure? Call **BTD** and they'll help you*



### STEP 2: GET READY

#### Demand and Response

- Be ready at your pickup location
- Be at the curb at the start of your pickup window time
- Be outside **10 to 15 minutes early**
- Drivers will wait **up to 5 minutes**



### STEP 3: BOARD & RIDE

- Pay for your fare (exact change recommended)
- Show ID if using a reduced or free fare
- Follow driver instructions
- You may share the ride with other passengers

*No-shows result in a penalty that must be paid before booking another trip*



### STEP 4: GET OFF & RETURN

#### Demand and Response

- Return trips must be scheduled in advance
- Confirm your return pickup time and location
- Be ready at your pickup location



### FARES

#### Fares Within the Same County (One-Way)

- **General Public:** \$3.50
- **Same Day:** \$5.50
- **Additional Trips:** \$2.50

#### Between Counties (One-Way)

- **Crossing 1 County:** \$4.00
- **Crossing 2 Counties:** \$5.00
- **Additional Trips:** \$2.00
- **Same Day (plus base & county fare):** \$2.00

#### Free Fare

- Children 2 and under
- PCA (with approval)

*Exact fare required (no change given)*



### ACCESSIBILITY

- All vehicles are ADA accessible
- Drivers provide assistance if needed
